



Additional tips for:

Liquid medications, as well as pills that are easier to dissolve in water than to crush.

Proportions may vary- you may need to adjust the amount of gel powder to address your specific needs.

1. Collect the "liquid" (whether it be liquid medication or dissolved pills) in the syringe.
2. With finger over tip remove the plunger and add gel powder at a ratio of 1:3, powder:liquid.
3. Replace the plunger, shake vigorously, tap down and carefully remove finger, push plunger up and assess mixture after about one minute.
 - If too thin, repeat the process and add a reduced quantity of powder until desired consistency is attained.
 - If the initial mixture is too thick pull in a small amount of water until the desired consistency is attained.

Prascend

Your vet has probably cautioned against crushing the tablets in order to avoid inhaling the medication. This can be easily overcome by dissolving the tablets in water and following the directions above for liquid medications.

Medications and Wormers in Paste Form

Dispense the amount of paste to be used into the dose syringe included in the kit. Add water thinning paste significantly. Then follow the above directions for liquid medication dosing*.

*Depending on size of horse and size of dosage required, this may need to be done in two rounds due to volume created.
